NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF HEARING ON PROPOSED RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CUMULATIVE FIRE FUND

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of Town of Yorktown, Delaware County, Indiana, that the Yorktown Town Council will consider at 9312 West Smith Street, Yorktown, Indiana 47396 at six o'clock pm on February 10, 2025, the re-establishment of a Cumulative Fire Fund under the provisions of Indiana Code 36-8-14-2 for all uses set out in I.C. 36-8-14-2.

The tax will be levied on all taxable real and personal property within the taxing district and will not exceed \$0.0333 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The proposed fund will be levied beginning with taxes due and payable in the year 2026. Taxpayers appearing at such hearing shall have the right to be heard thereon. The proposed tax rate for the Cumulative Fire Fund is subject to certification by the Department of Local Government Finance.

Within 30 days after the date of the adoption of the cumulative fund by the Yorktown Town Council, the Town of Yorktown will publish a Notice of Adoption.

Upon publication of the Notice of Adoption, 25 or more taxpayers in the taxing district may file a petition with the County Auditor not later than noon 30 days after the publication of the Notice of Adoption setting forth their objections to the proposed fund.
